Riding abilities.

First of all, you don't need to be an off-road *expert* to join our tours. But you do need a minimum of 2 year experience on riding your motorcycle. The Sri Lanka Secrets tour is a level 3 all-road tour (out of 5), and is perfect for those who have some experience with off-road riding and/or joined a (2 days) off-road course (like level 2 at [Off Road Skills in Wales](#)).

The pace is relaxed, it is not a competition. We are traveling, not racing and will take a break frequently. The days can be long, depending on many factors (punctures, weather etc.), so you have to be comfortable in most situations in order not to suffer fatigue too quickly. A flexible attitude and mind-set is needed.



There will be time enough to take pictures, movies, rest etc. We do want to emphasise that for our off-road tours you need to be healthy and in a good physical condition. The riding, in combination with the weather can make it challenging en strenuous.

Insurance(s) - other documents

Make sure that your travel insurance covers medical expenses in case of an accident or getting sick and you need to be hospitalised stay longer than expected and/or repatriated back home. A cancellation insurance is recommended. See our terms & conditions for our cancellations fees on our website.

The motorcycles have 3rd part and full damage insurance.

Passport needs to be at least 6 months valid upon arrival.

An International Driving Permit is **mandatory**.



What gear to bring:

The climate is warm and can be (very!) humid. So bring good **ventilating** gear (no gore-tex!) gear. A rehydration back-pack is highly recommended! (read a must ;). Same for good protection plastic off-road boots that protect your ankle / leg. It can save your holiday.

Light waterproof gear (jacket/pants) in case it might rain. Thin summer gloves and a base layer that is cooling down. There is a small rack on the bike, so you can strap your own waterproof bag with rain gear etc. on it.

Your big hard suitcase you can leave in the hotel during the tour. Please bring a smaller soft-bag to bring your personal items and clothes for in the evening. This will take less space than your big travel suitcase. In case you have any questions what to bring, please do contact us.

General info area of traveling

Sri Lanka, historically known as Ceylon, got its independence since 1948.

It has a population of approximately 22 million and is home to several cultures, languages and ethnicities like the Sinhales, Tamils and Veddas.

Main religions are Buddhism (70,2%), Hinduism (12,6%), Muslim (9,7%) , Christianity (7,4%) and others.



Climate Sri Lanka.

With an average temperature of 27 - 28° C, Sri Lanka is one of the hottest countries in the world. The climate of Sri Lanka is classified as 'Tropical Monsoon' climatic zone. The monsoonal conditions are separated into two periods: from May to September is in the southwest monsoon period and from December to February is in the northeast monsoon period. The rainfall pattern is influenced by the monsoon winds.

Practical info.

For Sri Lanka there are two associated plug types, types D and G. Plug type D is the plug which has three round pins in a triangular pattern and plug type G is the plug which has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Sri Lanka operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
